From the Molalla River School District:

After a public hearing in September 2016, the Molalla River School District Mascot Committee began meeting to learn and to re-design the Molalla High School Logo. With the assistance of the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer for The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde as well as the Director of the Clackamas County Historical Society, Mascot Committee members have learned a great deal about the Molalla people, one of the five banded tribes of Grand Ronde.

The committee's process has been participatory, seeking concept image input from students from across the district. The committee's work has, at times, been complicated, and it has always remained exciting! The process of choosing a new logo for Molalla High School is an historical event. With a a satisfactory agreement signed between the school board and Tribal Council, the name "Indians" remains for Molalla High School. The privilege of keeping the name "Molalla Indians" is an honor our committee did not take lightly. We are the only school in the State that was granted this exception, and we committed to identify a culturally relevant, historically accurate, entirely respectful image to replace the current mascot.



Those wonderful folks at Clarkes Grange have agreed to cater our luncheon once again. We want to acknowledge that much of the money they earn goes back to many worthwhile school & community projects.
