This scholarship is funded by MHS Alumni donations and individuals supporting MASF's Scholarship Vision.

The Alumni Association of Molalla High School is proud to be able to offer this scholarship to any graduating MRSD senior for the purpose of achieving any accredited career training program including a 2-year Associates Degree, apprenticeship, or other technical/career training program. If you are going to a community college as a step to receive just an associate degree or additional training and then continue to a job, use this application on which to apply. If you are attending a community college to receive a transfer degree and then attend a four-year college, please use the "2021 Molalla Alumni College" application.

The following list contains examples of fields of study that qualify for this scholarship but are not necessarily limited to this list: plumbing, electrical, dental hygienist, culinary/foods, art, beauty, welding, mechanical, agricultural, forestry, fire fighter, nursing (CNA, PNL) massage therapy.

Award: Multiple scholarships available— number and amount at discretion of committee

Eligibility: A current senior attending Molalla High School or affiliated charter school who has maintained at least a 2.0 accumulated GPA and plans to attend an accredited institution or trade school leading to a certificate of completion.

Where: Any accredited community college, trade school, or vocational institution.

Selection Based On:

1. Attendance record
2. Community and school involvement
3. Personal character
4. Ability to follow directions

Deadline: This Application may be mailed to MASF, P.O. Box 1050, Molalla, Oregon 97038. Mail early enough to be received on or before 5 p.m., Wednesday, April 6, 2022. You may also hand deliver them to Joan Deardorff at Doubletree's office in the Mainstreet Showhouse, 115 E. Main Street, Suite #9, in Molalla.

Procedure:

1. Complete **all** the information required on the application
2. Staple application pages together in this order (please, **no folders**)
 - Cover page
 - Activities, awards, and commendations list
 - Letters of recommendation from high school staff, family friends or community members
 - High School transcript through the second trimester
 - Work Study program information, if available
3. Winner (s) will be notified on the date of your Senior Awards or by mail

Also attach to your application, one letter of recommendation from an adult who is **not related to you** and is **not part** of the school setting. **This person must identify himself or herself** and how he/she knows you and the circumstances for your relationship with this person. (If this is not done by the person composing the letter of recommendation, please write who this person is and how they know you on the bottom of their letter before attaching it to your application.) [i.e. Church pastor, Camp Fire advisor, Boy Scout advisor, doctor, family friend, etc.] **NOTE:** Your personal friend, although an adult, **may not** write this letter.
3. On a separate sheet of paper, please explain any unusual absences or circumstances not otherwise explained in your application or essays of which the committee members should be aware.
